To further improve the climbing experience and expand the terrain of movement, we have added climbing holds on the left and right side panels.

Dimensions

- The board is 4.5x4.5 meters (14.7x14.7 ft)
- It has a 80cm kickboard (2.62 ft)

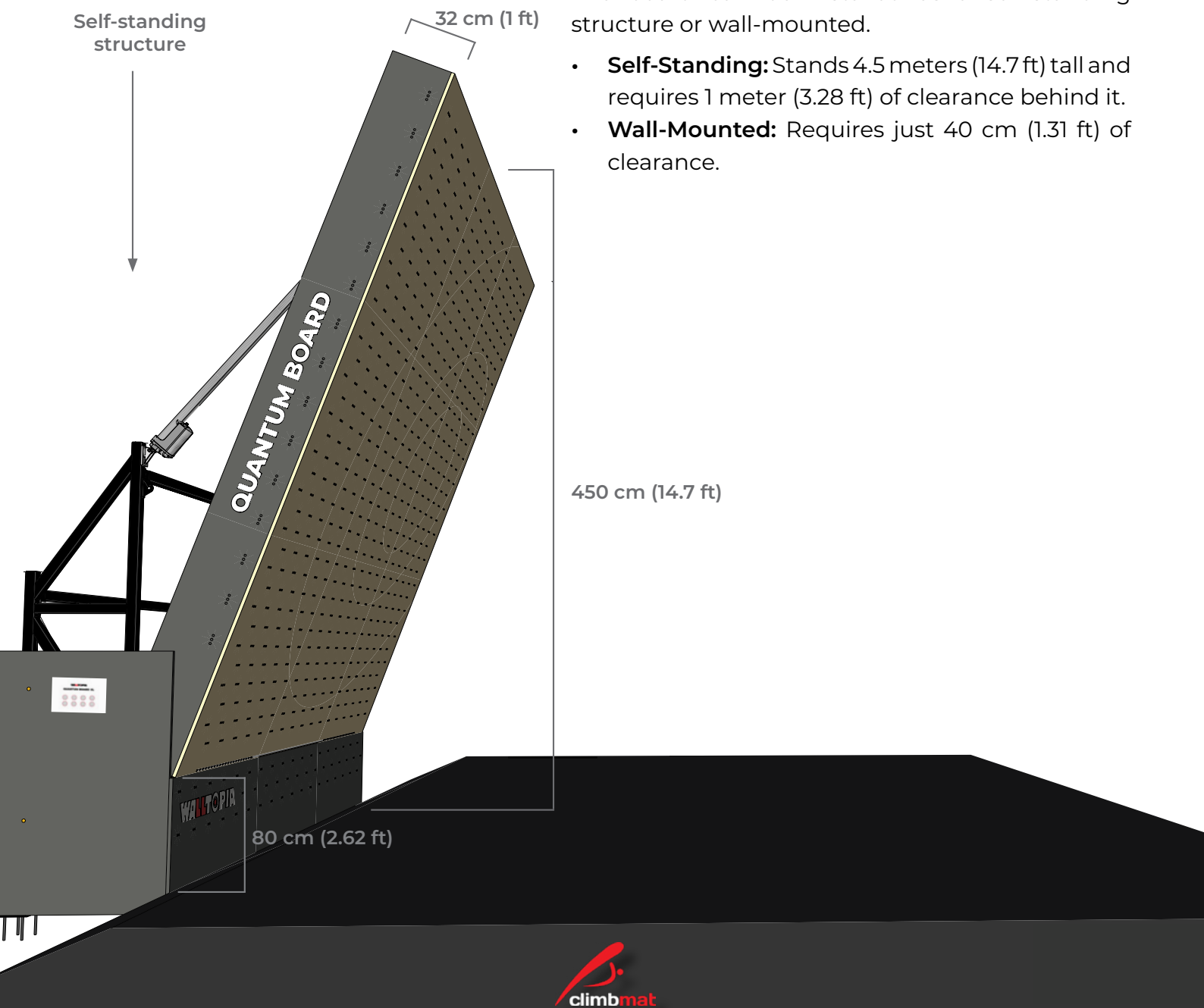
Adjustable angle system

- Adjustable screen with which you can tilt the board from 25° to 60°.

The Structure

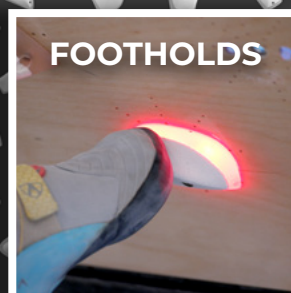
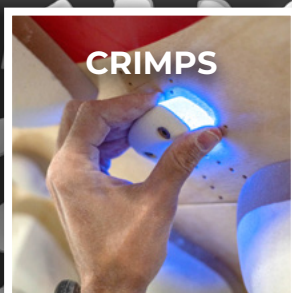
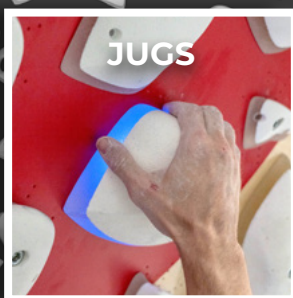
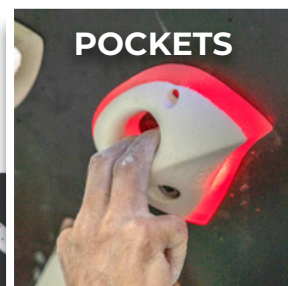
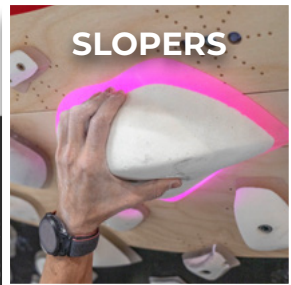
The board can be installed as a self-standing structure or wall-mounted.

- **Self-Standing:** Stands 4.5 meters (14.7 ft) tall and requires 1 meter (3.28 ft) of clearance behind it.
- **Wall-Mounted:** Requires just 40 cm (1.31 ft) of clearance.



HRT 500

The HRT “500” set has everything you need — jugs, slopers, pinches, pockets, uncut edge crimps and technical footholds. The holds are made from high quality polyurethane and **SKUISH** material.



SKUISH

SKUISH is a game-changing material developed by Composite X to transform climbing holds. These polyurethane holds are coated with a special rubber layer, making them super comfortable and gentle on your skin.

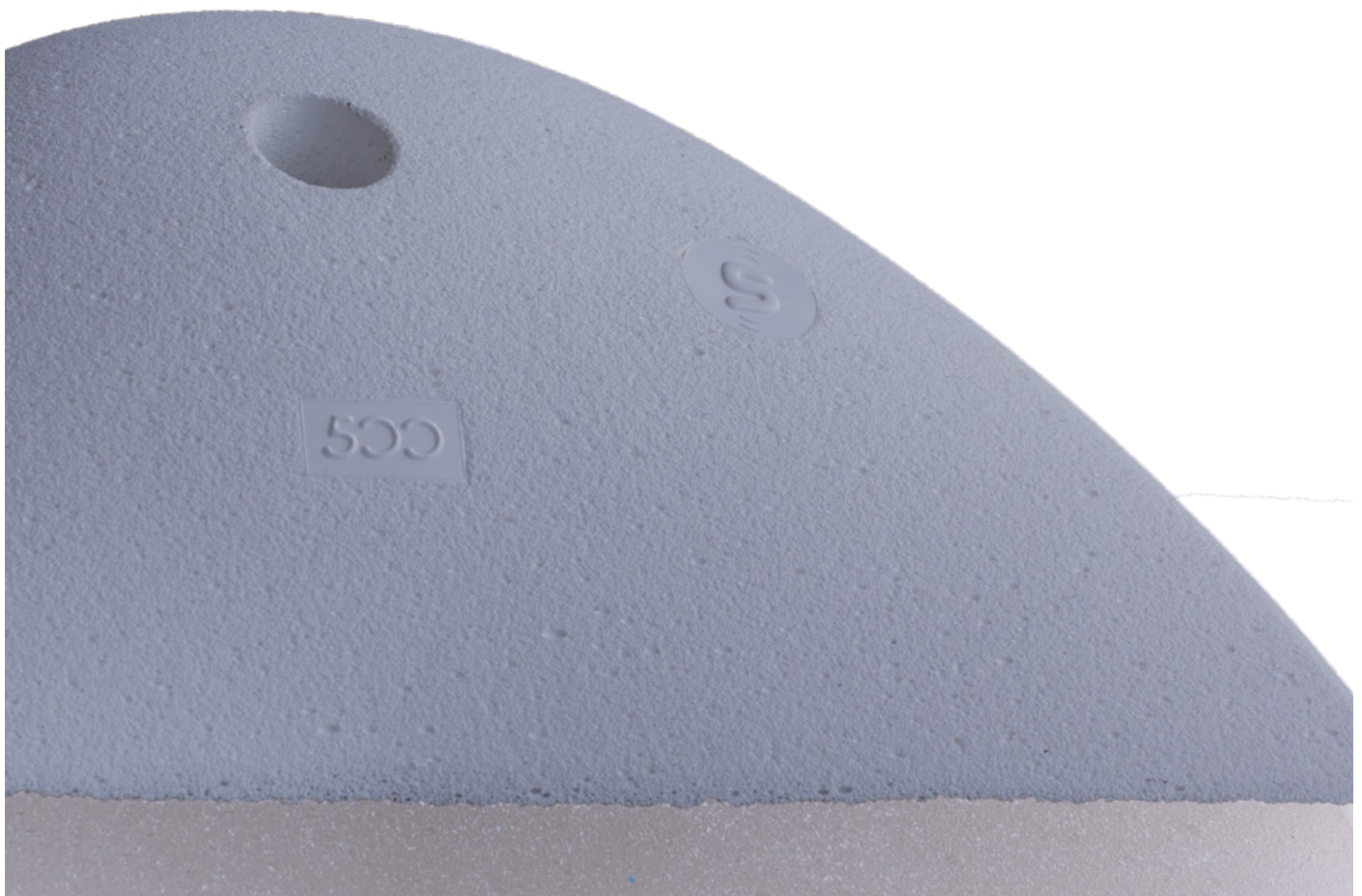
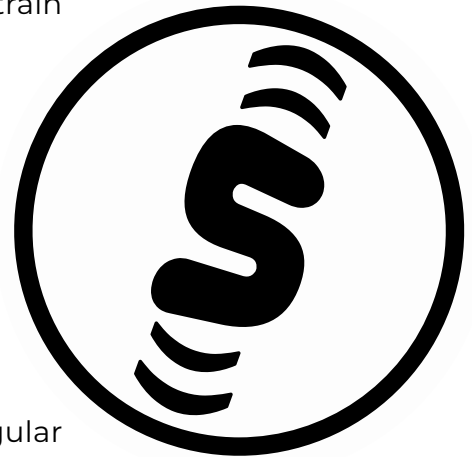

The SKUISH climbing holds are easier to maintain than regular polyurethane holds.

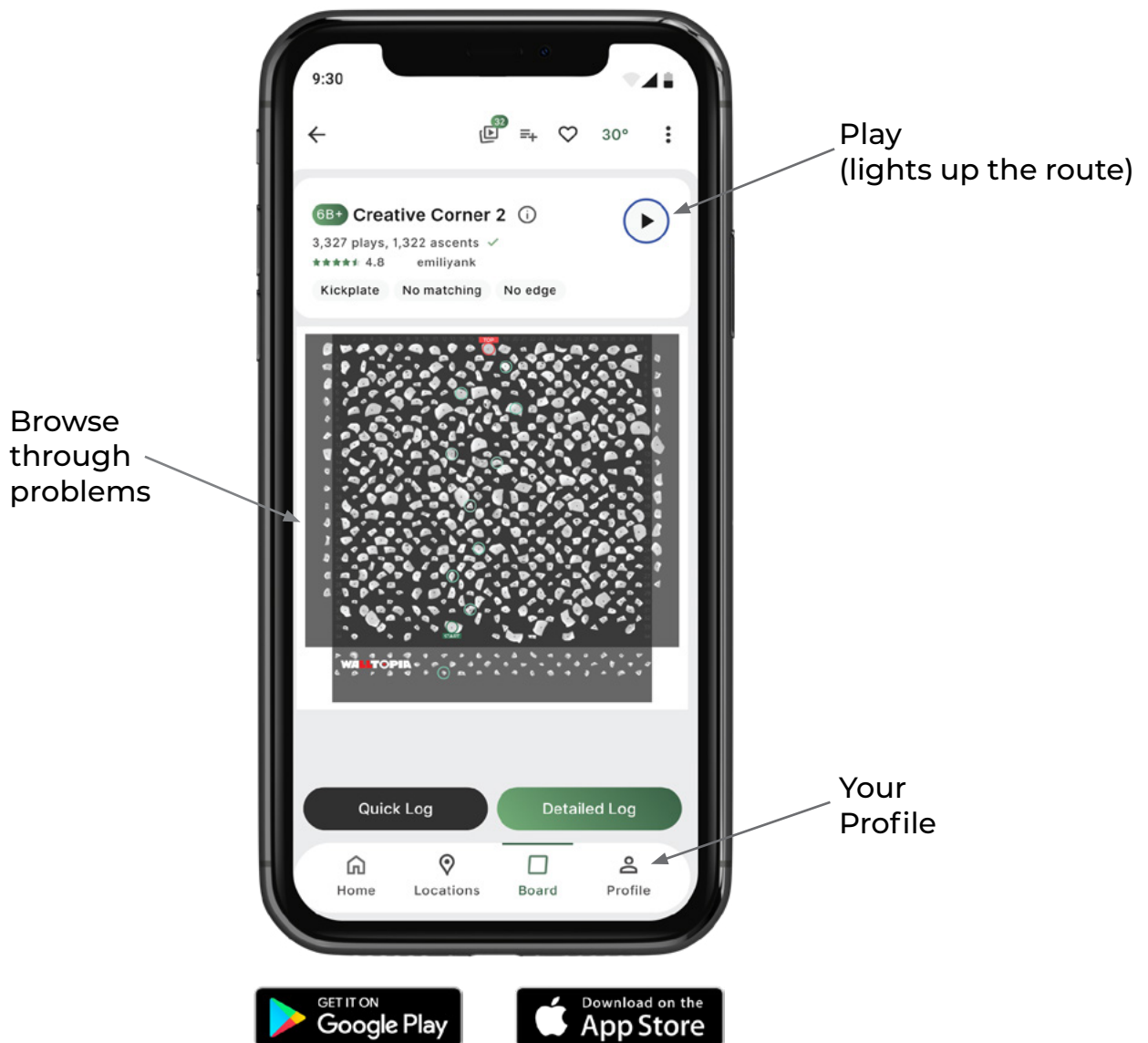


eWalls App

The Walltopia Board functions with the eWalls application. With it, you can create your own profile and browse through all the routes set by other climbers. Utilize the board's unique features, such as multiplayer mode, and use the collection of training programs to improve your technique.

eWalls App

Multiplayer Mode

The eWalls App is the first climbing app to enable multiple routes to be illuminated simultaneously, allowing climbers to train and climb together in real time.

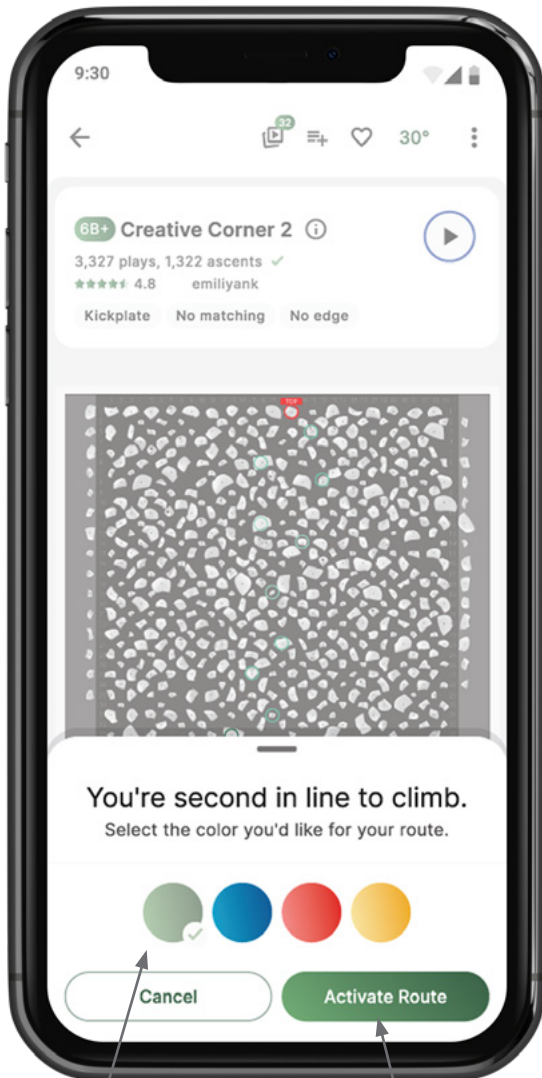
When you start climbing, select a problem and click “Play”.

If a second climber wants to climb and display a problem on the board, they can. The app will ask them to choose a color and display their route in that color. They can browse through the routes while the first climber is still climbing.

This won't turn off the holds of the first climber's route.

If a hold is already lit up by the first climber and the second climber wants to use it, the app will signal that the route cannot be displayed due to a conflict.

The app can support 4 climbers at the same time.

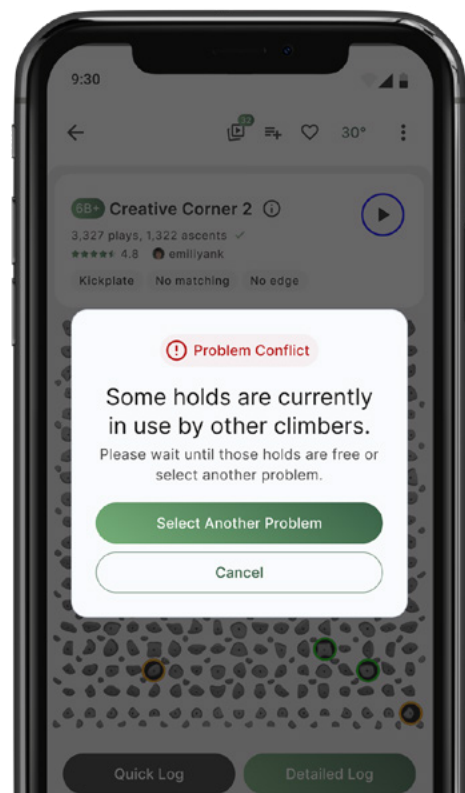


Choose a color to display a route on the board

And then click on “Activate Route”

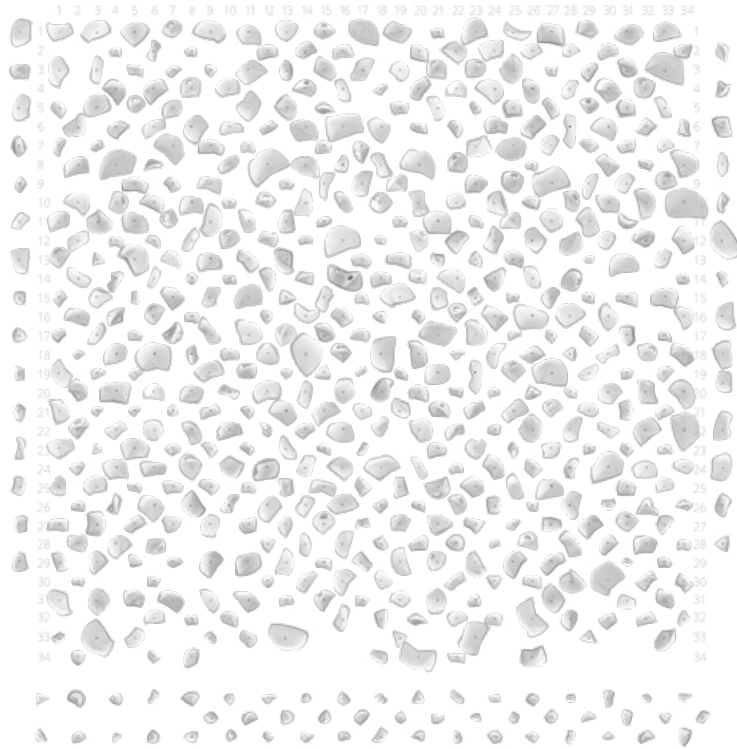

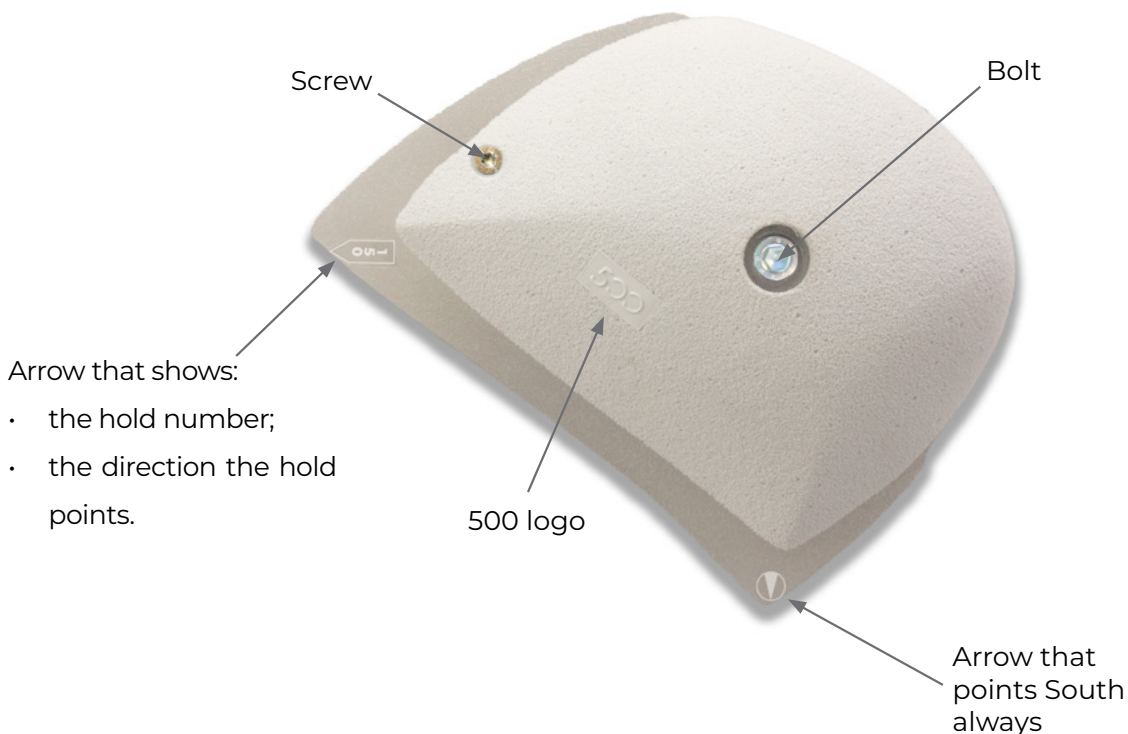
Easy and Precise Setting

Since the board features 593 holds in total, our goal was to make the installation and setting on the board as easy and intuitive as possible. To ensure precise and easy hold orientation, we have placed indicators both on the board and on each climbing hold.



The “500” Holds

Each hold in the set comes with specific indicators that show the direction of the hold on the board, as well as the number of the hold.



Easy and Precise Setting

Each hold in the set has a specific location and direction on the board. On the board, you'll find the number of the hold, a line that always points south, and another line indicating the hold's direction. The direction line aligns with the arrow on the hold, which can be rotated to point North, North East, East, South East, South, South West, West, or North West.
